

Cottesmore Hunt Country map

It is 40-years, more than a generation, since the last map of the Cottesmore Hunt country was published. This year the Hunt Supporters Club is extremely pleased to have been able to commission the artistic talent of Mrs Celia Slack to bring a fresh new vision of the country. Celia's son George, who is also an accomplished artist and enthusiastic hunt supporter, has painted two of the vignettes. Celia is a life-long hunt supporter, originally from Grange Farm, Stapleford and now living in Lincolnshire. Celia works in mainly pastel, watercolour and acrylics and is particularly known for her canine and equine portraits including hounds, foxes and hunt scenes.

The original copy of 2014 map will be auctioned at the Christmas Lunch and is authenticated by the artist and signed by the current mastership.

We have made available a strictly limited edition run of 50 high-quality prints that have been checked and approved by Celia for quality & colour correctness before being signed and numbered by the artist. The size of the print, excluding frame is approximately 18" x 23" and is printed on 300gsm, high white matt paper, double mounted and framed in one of 3 styles. Maps will be available on a first come first served basis and there will be no further prints issued.

Prints are available framed only; signed, numbered and dated in a choice of one of 3 styles, matt black, Oak (natural wax), Oak (dark wax). All prints are double mounted to produce a high quality map that will last for another generation and beyond.
